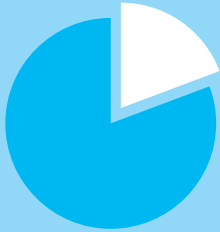

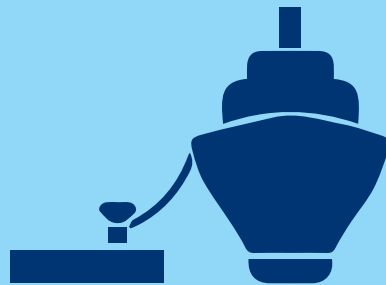
Cruise tourism

€29.4bn

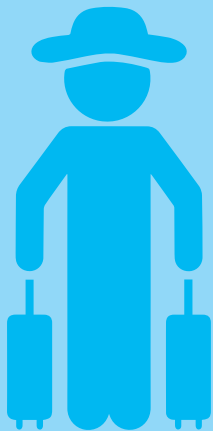
